


JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

The Alaska Department of Natural Resources seeks to fill the full-time exempt "Chief Geologist" position, which serves as State Geologist under the Commissioner of the Department and oversees the operations of the Division of Geological & Geophysical Surveys. The successful candidate will manage the Division's overall program of research, analysis, and information distribution and will provide strategic advice and support to the Commissioner consistent with the mission of the Division and the best interests of the State of Alaska. Duties will include supervising the Division's permanent staff, including geologists, contract geologists, and administrative personnel and coordinating communication with other divisions and branches of state government. Required capabilities include strong team-building, leadership, and communications skills and the ability to design and implement complex multidisciplinary geologic programs. Required experience includes professional application of an advanced degree in the geological sciences and managerial experience overseeing teams of geologists with diverse academic backgrounds.
