

PERMAFROST

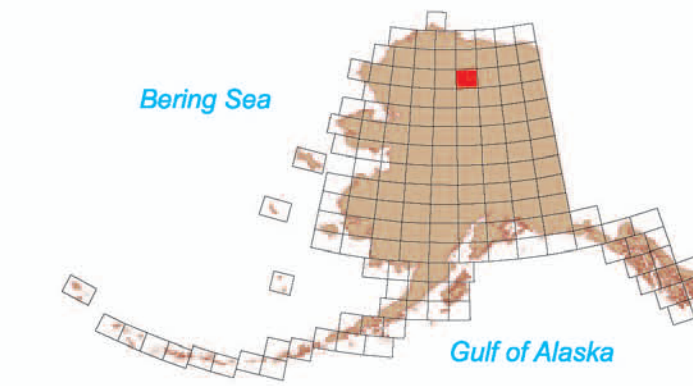
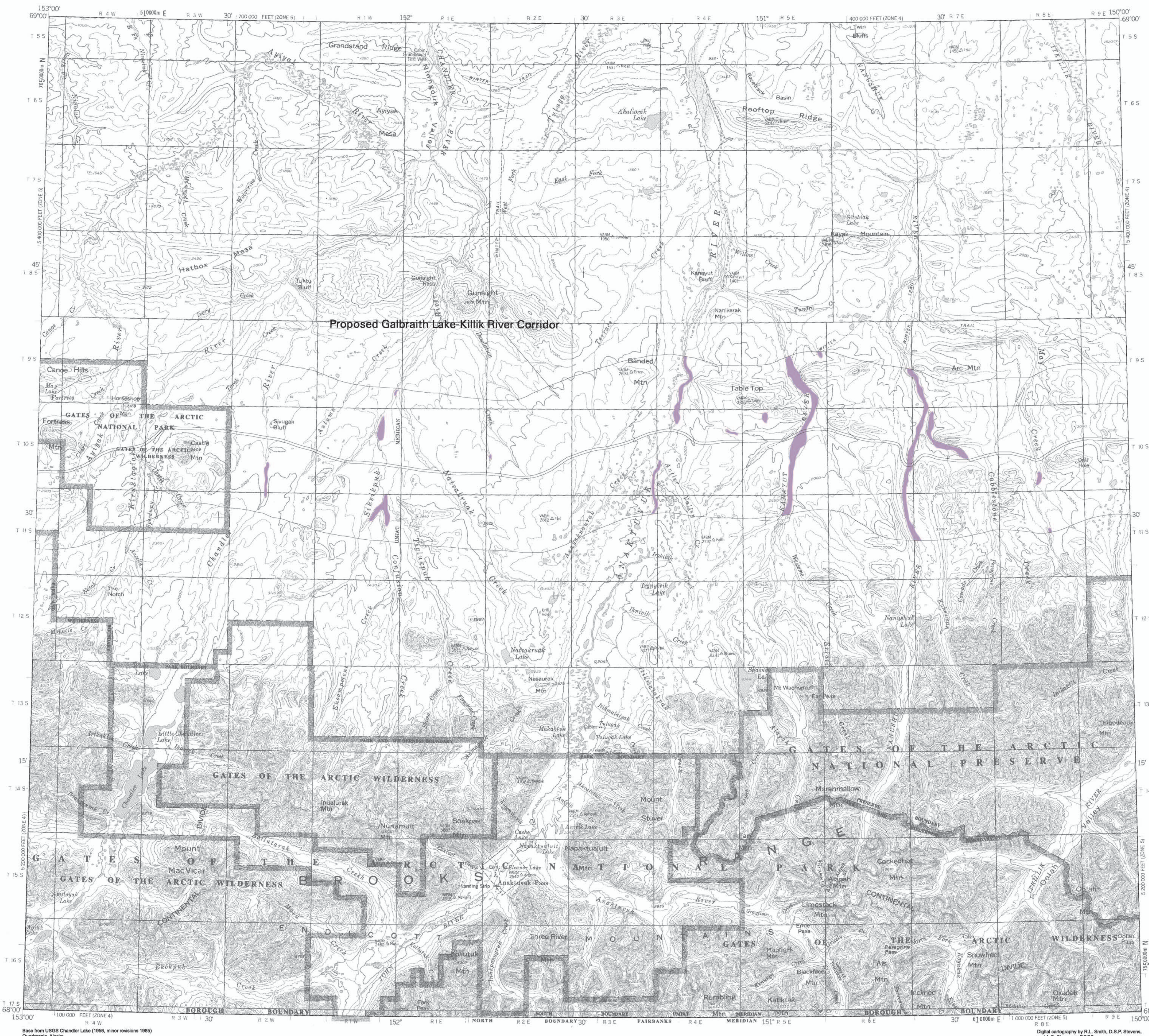
Perennially frozen ground is continuous in this quadrangle.

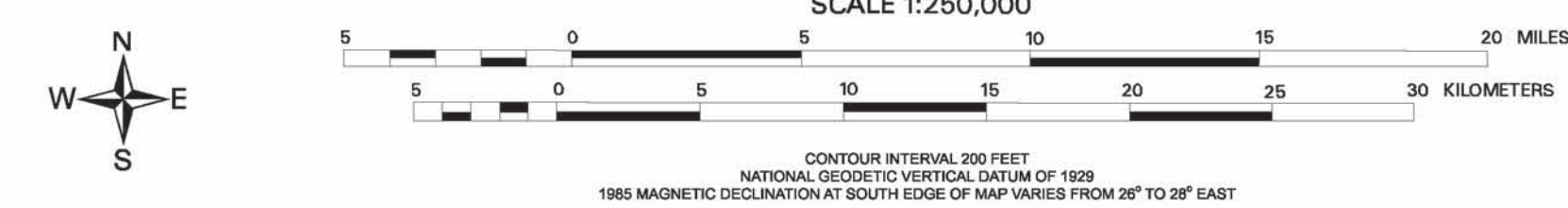
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Location map for Chandler Lake Quadrangle
