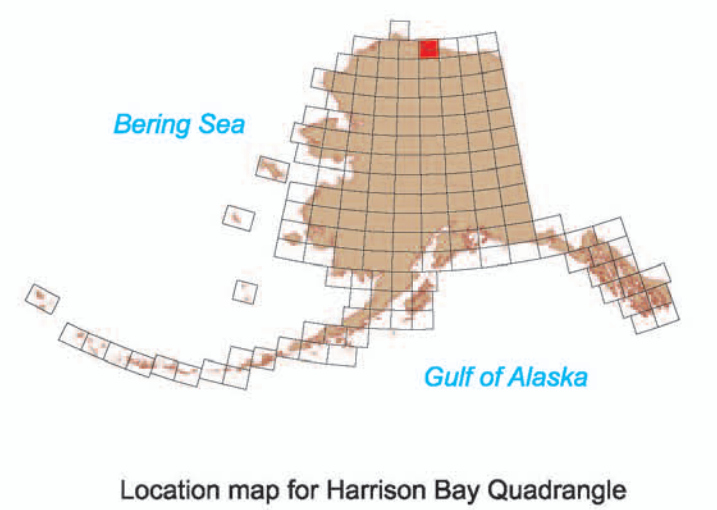


PERMAFROST
