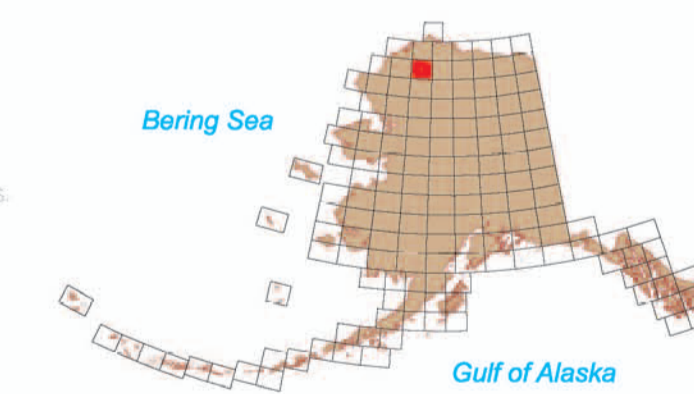
Perennially frozen ground is continuous in this quadrangle.

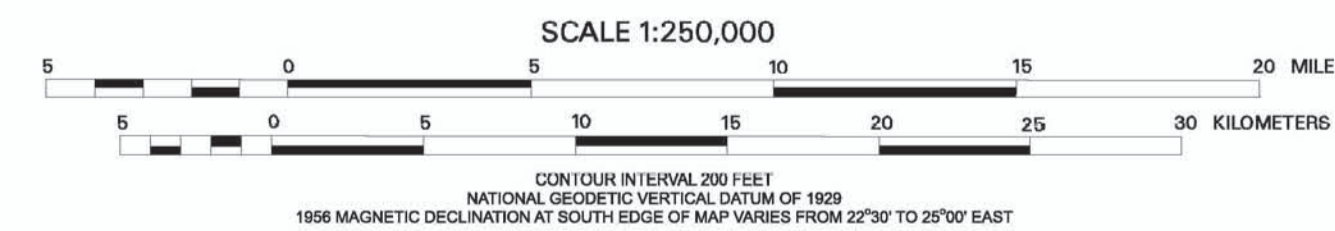
