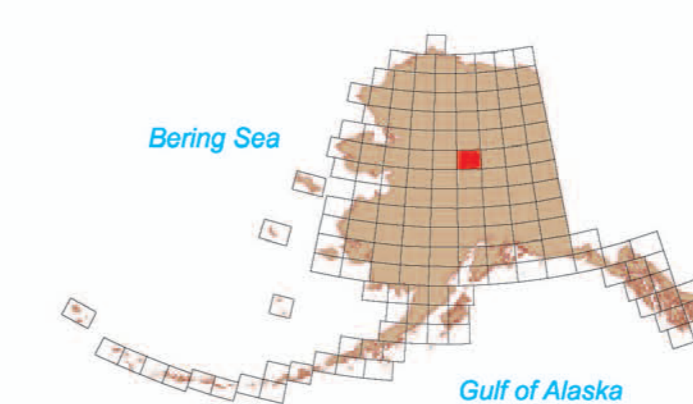


DESCRIPTION OF MAP UNITS

Moderate - A 1:250,000- or 1:125,000-scale geologic map is available; known to be generally reliable because of limited field observations, a few laboratory tests, or both; interpretation of 1:625,000- or larger scale aerial photographs is not verified by field observations.
