



DESCRIPTION OF MAP UNITS

UNCONSOLIDATED DEPOSITS

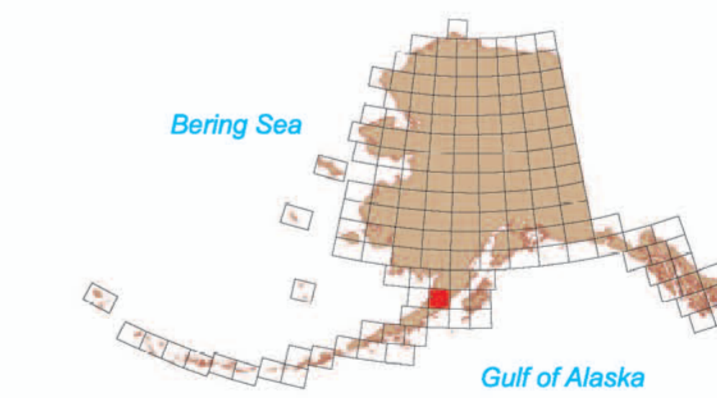
- cm** Chiefly (estimated greater than 80%) clean sand and gravel. Rare oversized material. Includes GW and GP (Unified Soil Classification).
- cs** Mixed coarse and fine material. Estimated 20-80% coarse, granular deposits with considerable oversized material. Includes GM and GC (Unified Soil Classification).

BEDROCK

- bu** Undifferentiated bedrock lithologies. May be deeply weathered.

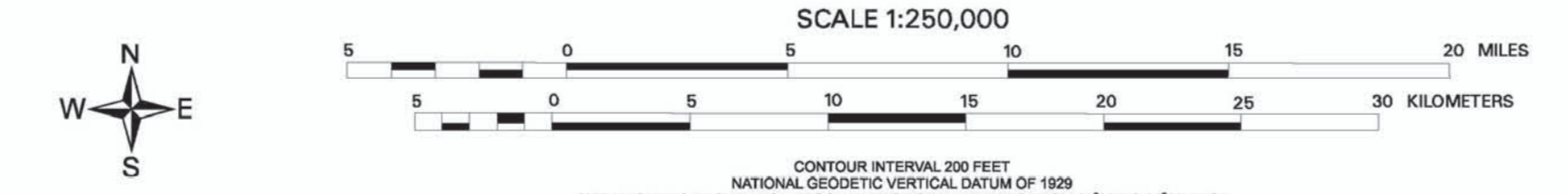
