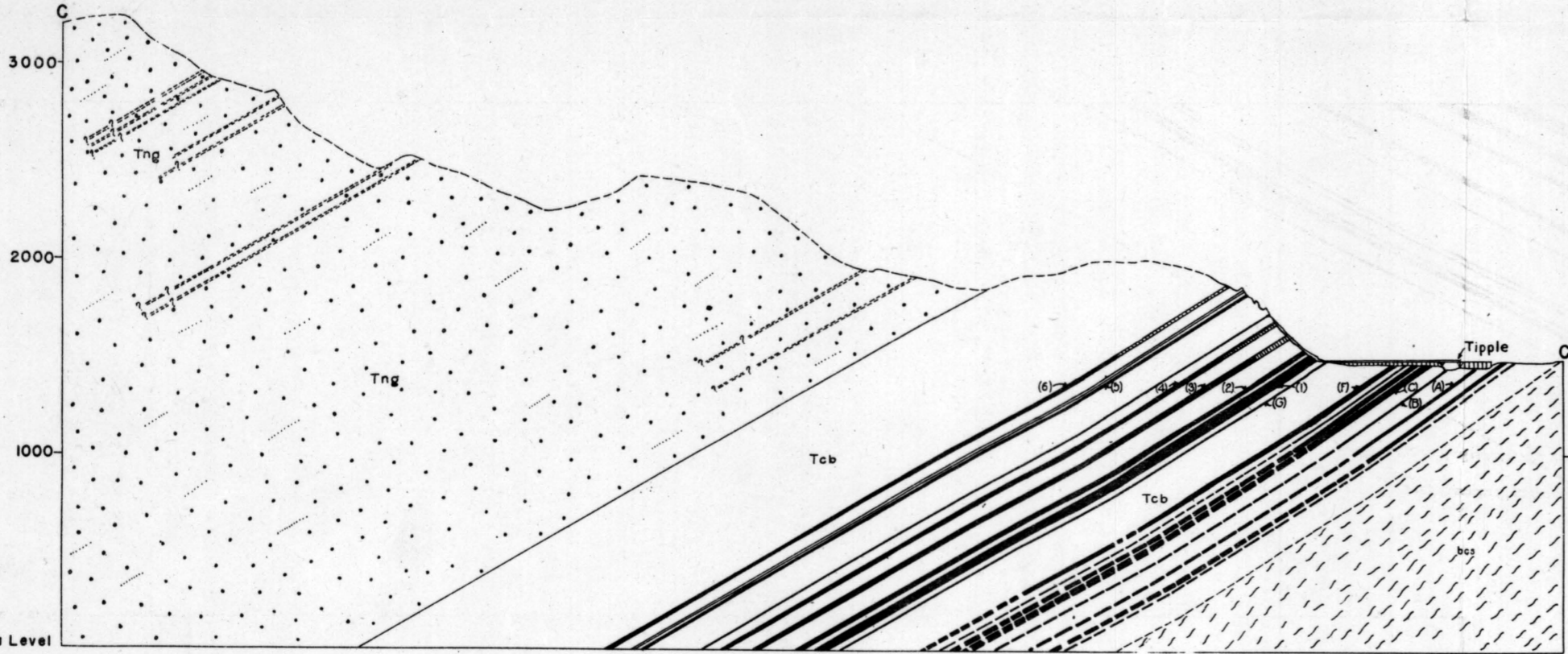
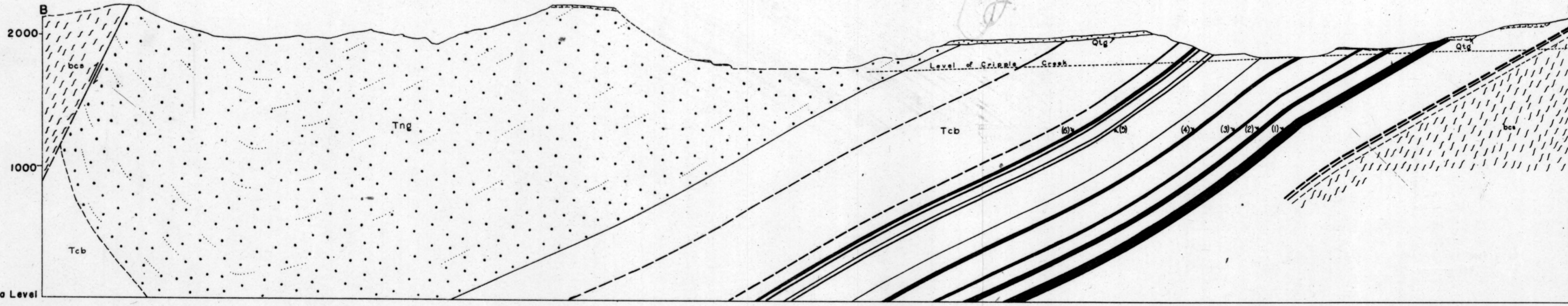






FIG. 6: VERTICAL CROSS SECTIONS
