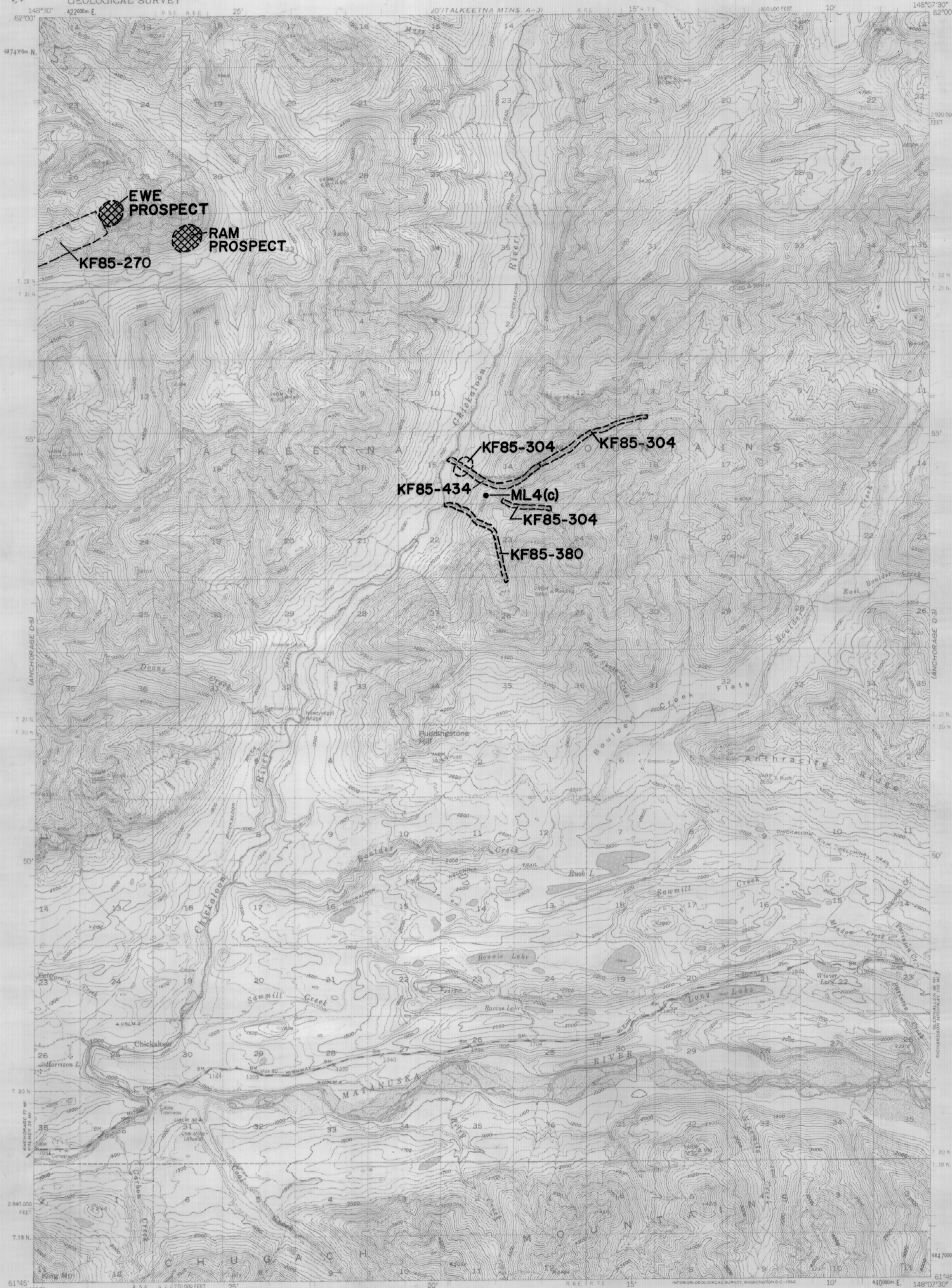

Land Management, Folio S-1, Seward Meridian

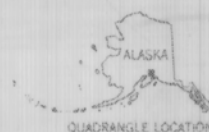
