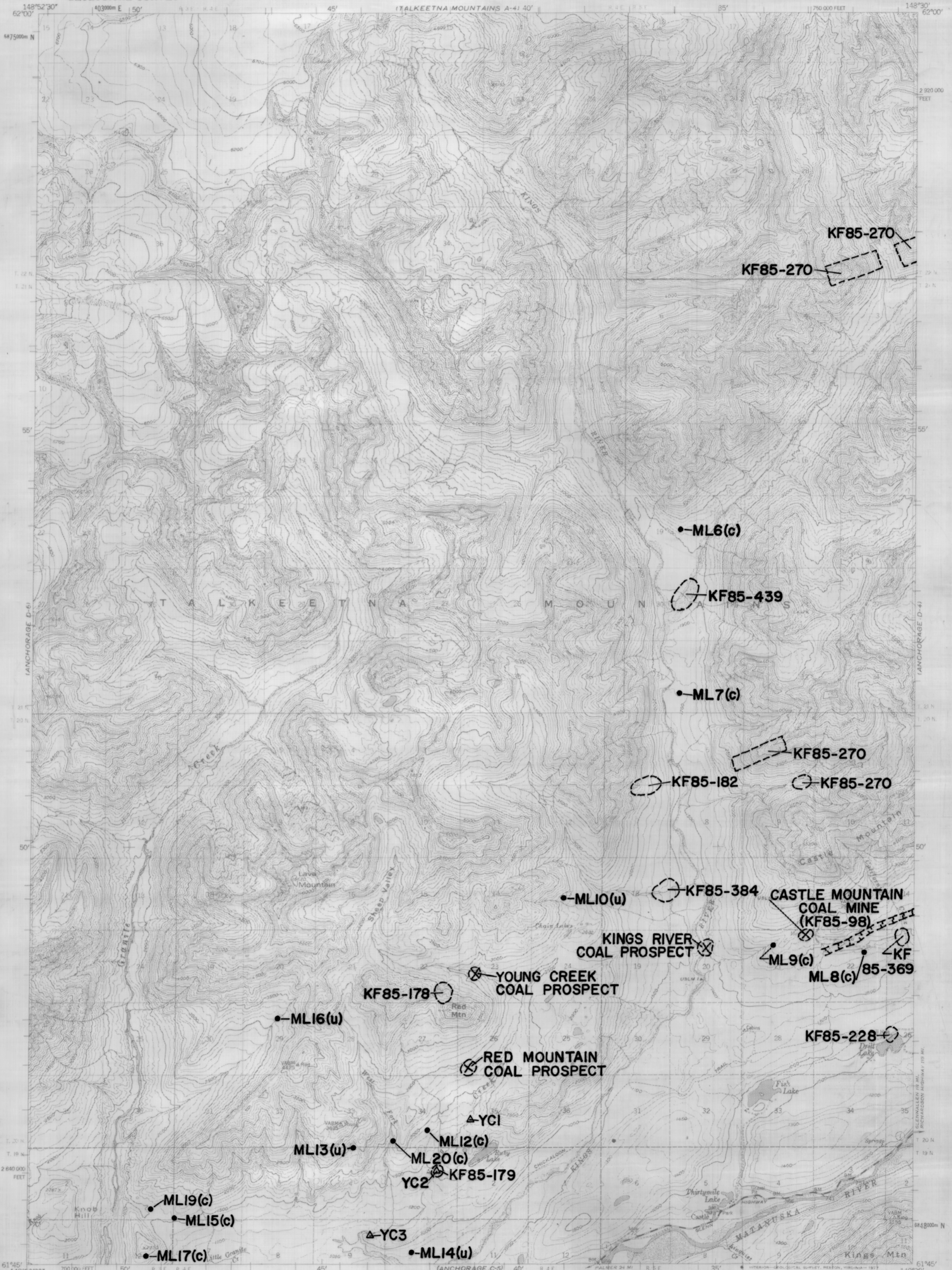
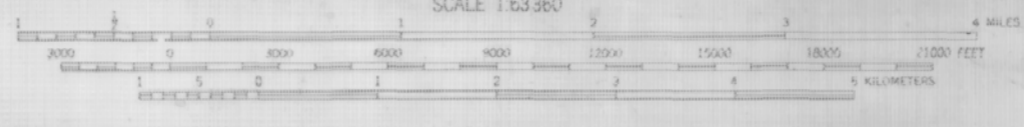

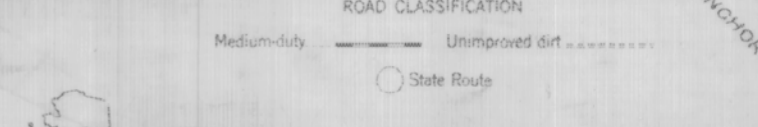
ANCHORAGE (D-5) QUADRANGLE
