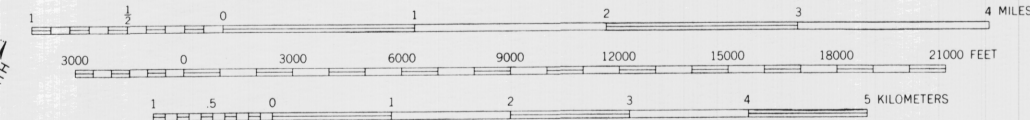
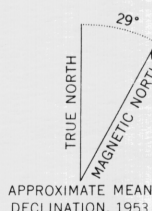
VALDEZ (A-5) QUADRANGLE
