



EXPLANATION

SEDIMENTARY ROCKS

- Quaternary: Sands, gravels, silts, etc.
- Jurassic: Tuffaceous slate and conglomerate
- Carboniferous (Mississippian): Limestone
- Carboniferous (Mississippian): Slate and schist, locally containing many intrusive masses, mostly of dioritic character, but with some more basic types

IGNEOUS ROCKS

- Post-Carboniferous to Post-Jurassic: Diorite and closely related granular intrusive rocks
