- Shaler, Beaver, and Captains plutons
- Small intrusive bodies cutting volcanic and sedimentary rocks
- Recrystallized wallrocks

Aplites, large plutons, small intrusives, and recrystallized wallrocks are represented, respectively, by approximately 17, 163, 35, and 43 specimens, except in distributions dealing with plagioclase composition, where they are represented, respectively, by approximately 13, 158, 29, and 56 specimens. Amphibole percentages include amphibole altered from pyroxene
