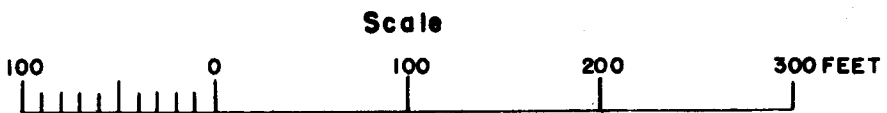
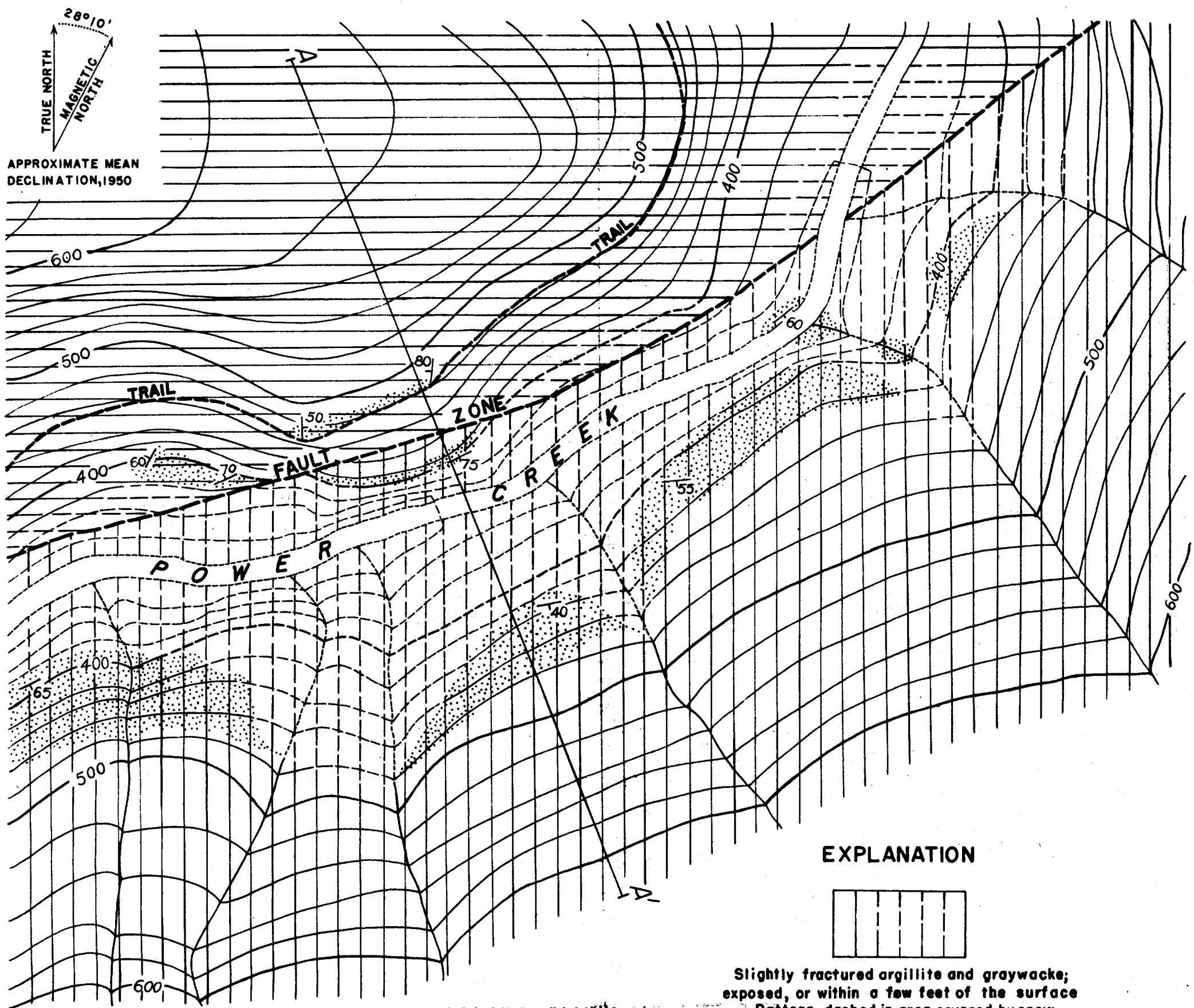
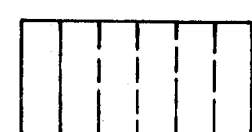


Horizontal and vertical scales are equal
SECTION ALONG THE LINE A-A'

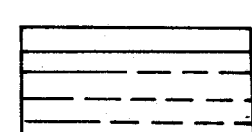


Contour interval 20 feet
