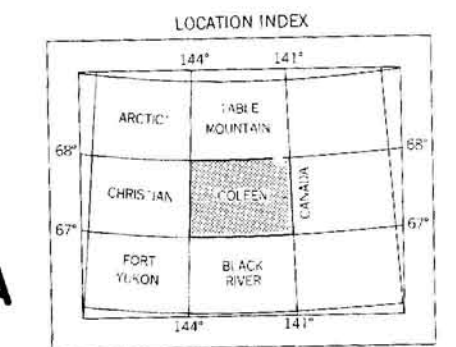
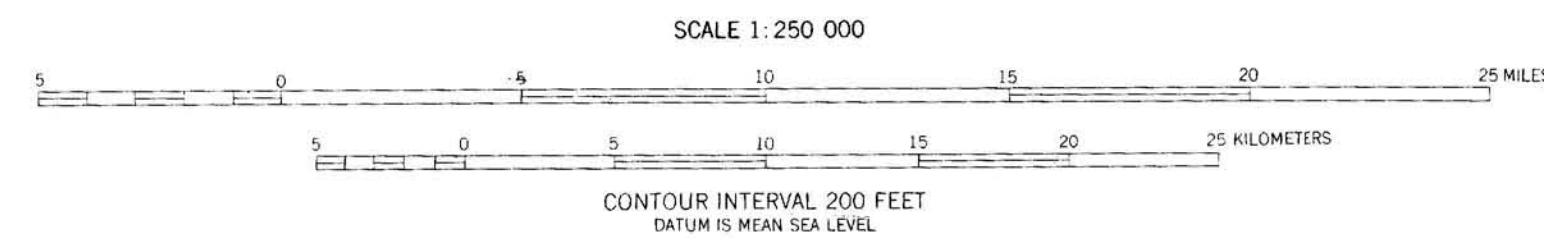
- 1 Porcupine River: Joesting, 1942, p. 19 -- nickeliferous alum.
