About 21,017,000 lbs. of placer gold was produced from Alaska between 1880 and 1979

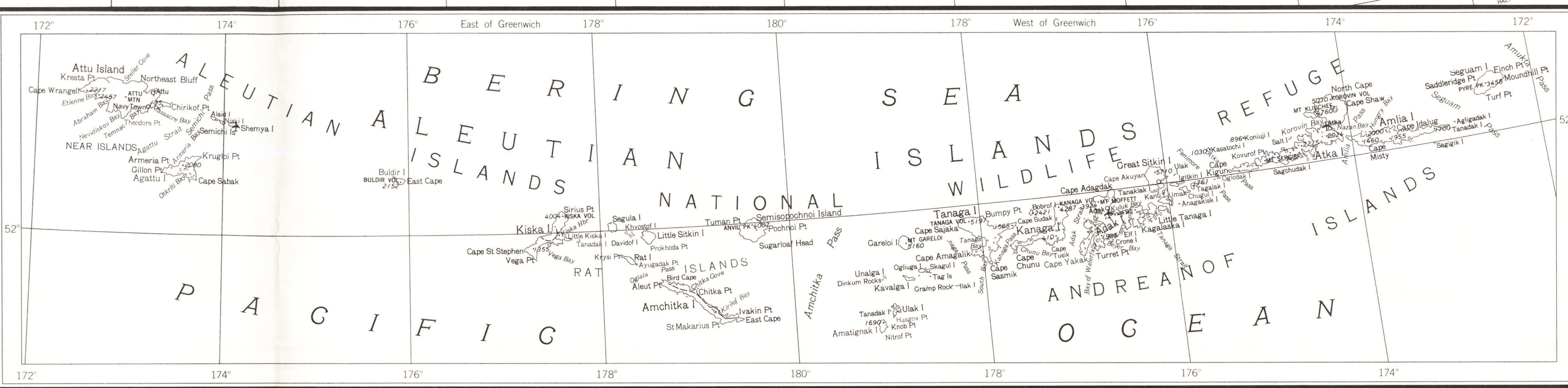
Approximately two-thirds of the total came from several formations and the area near Fairbanks

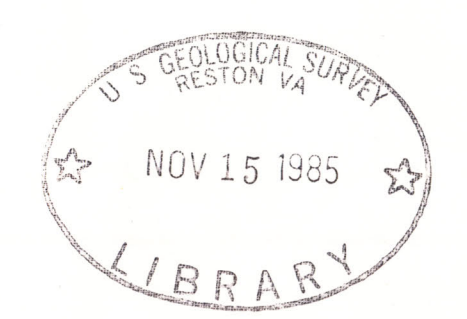
