Area containing one or more lead deposits

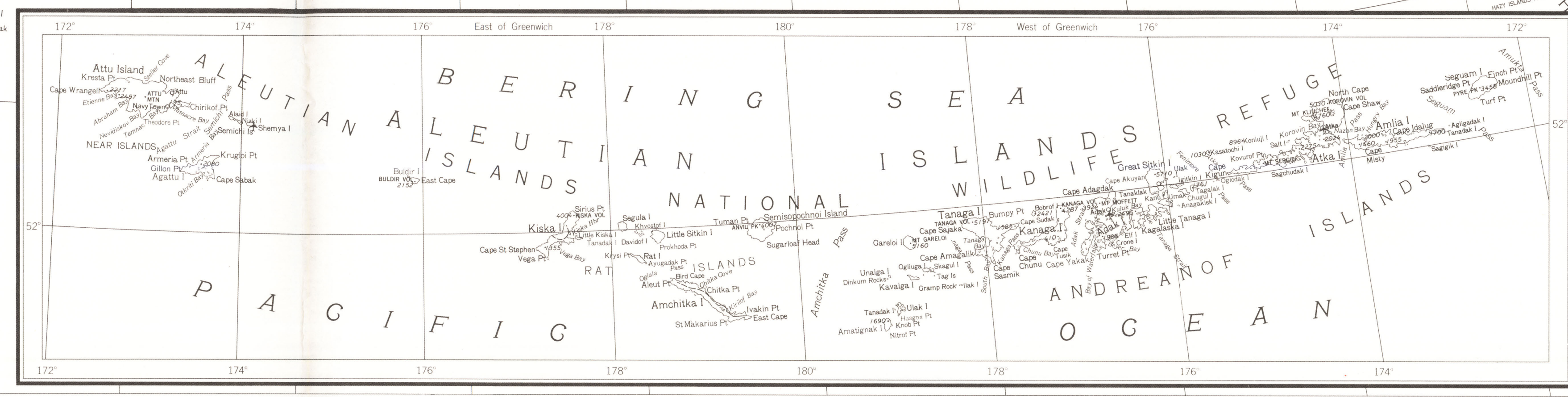

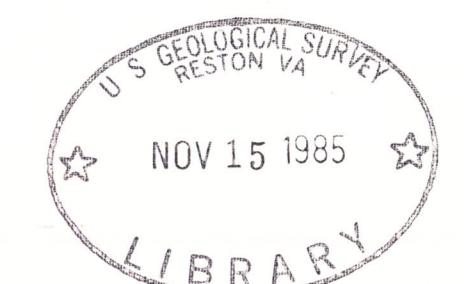
