● Area containing one or more occurrences of antimony minerals

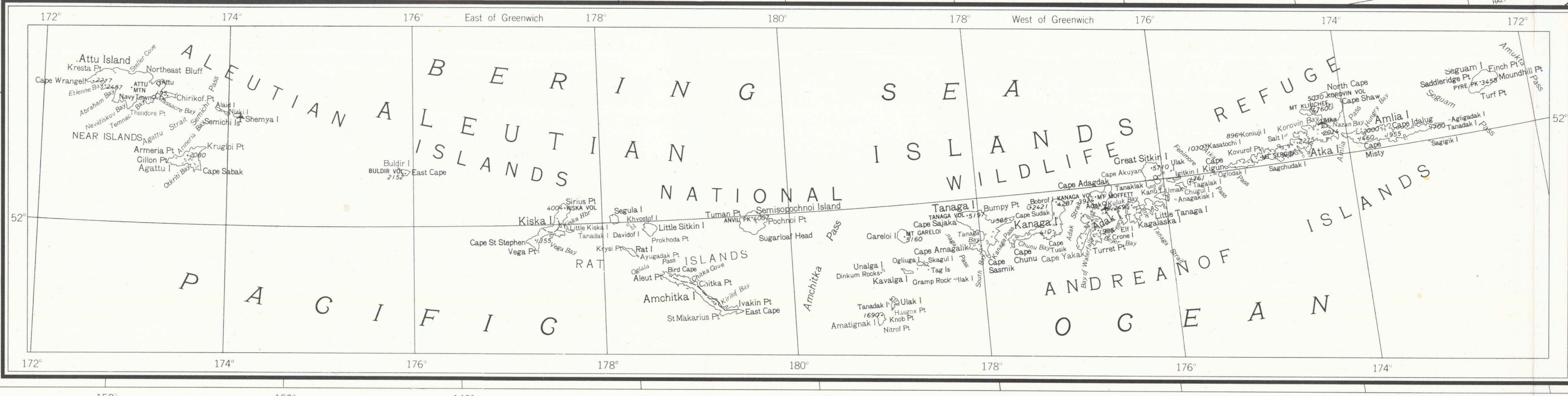
Circular areas are 10 kilometers in diameter; numbers are keyed to reference for Antimony production from Alaska between 1945 and 1982 and 10,315,790 pounds (Blair and others, 1982, 1984). The Cordova property (locality 22) and the Starbuck Mine (locality 39) have been the major producers of antimony in Alaska.
