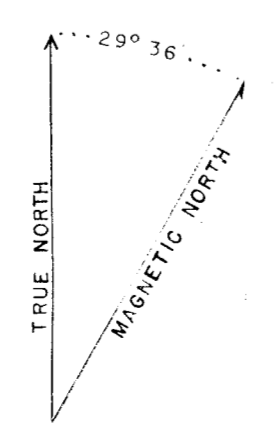




EXPLANATION
