

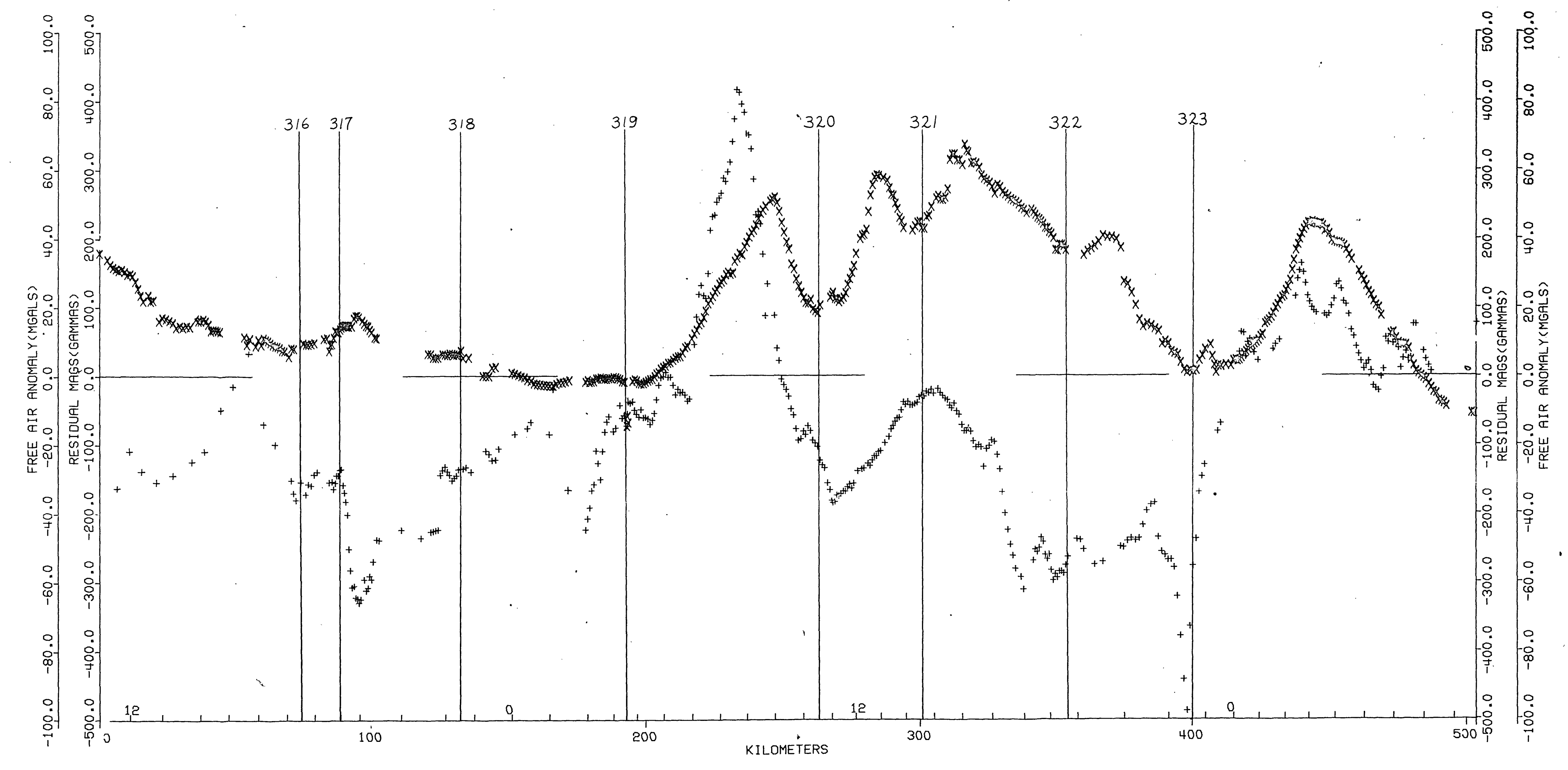

Times are referenced to Alaskan Daylight Time (ship time), nine hours earlier than Greenwich Mean Time. Geophysical data obtained using a proton-precession magnetometer and a ship-borne gravimeter. Residual magnetic anomalies obtained by subtracting the International Geomagnetic Reference Field from the observed magnetic field.

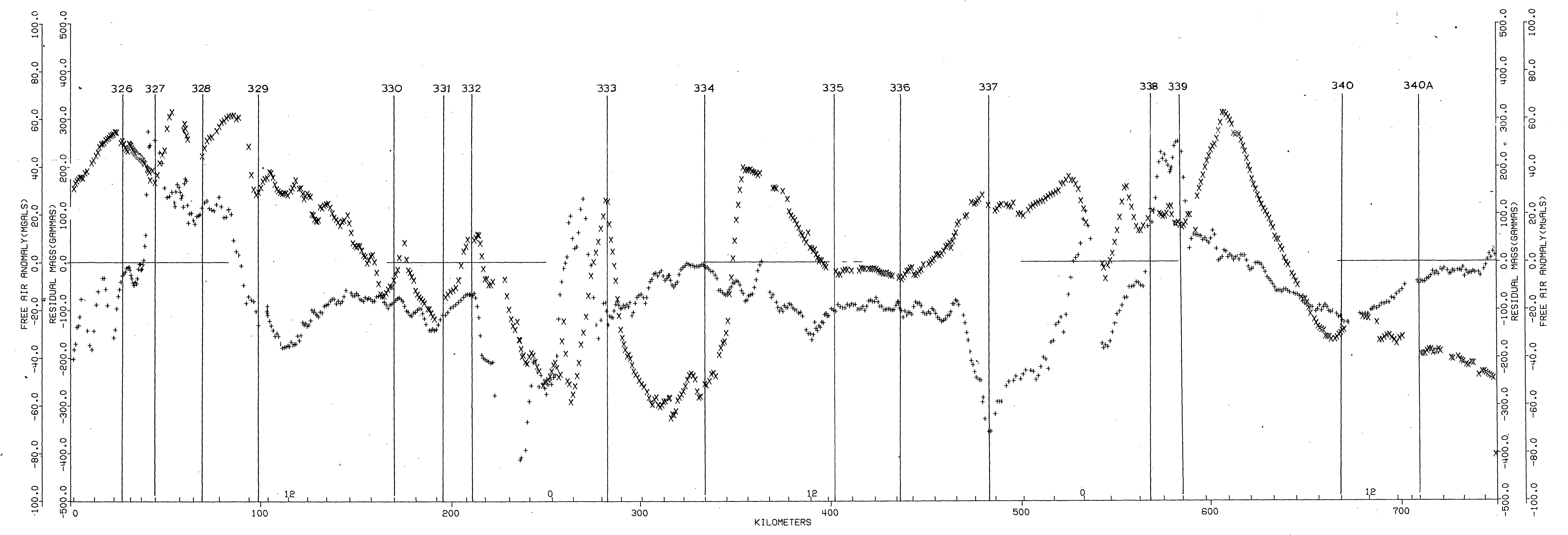
