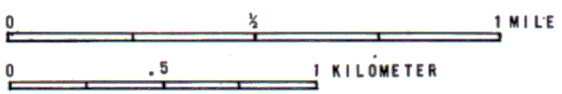
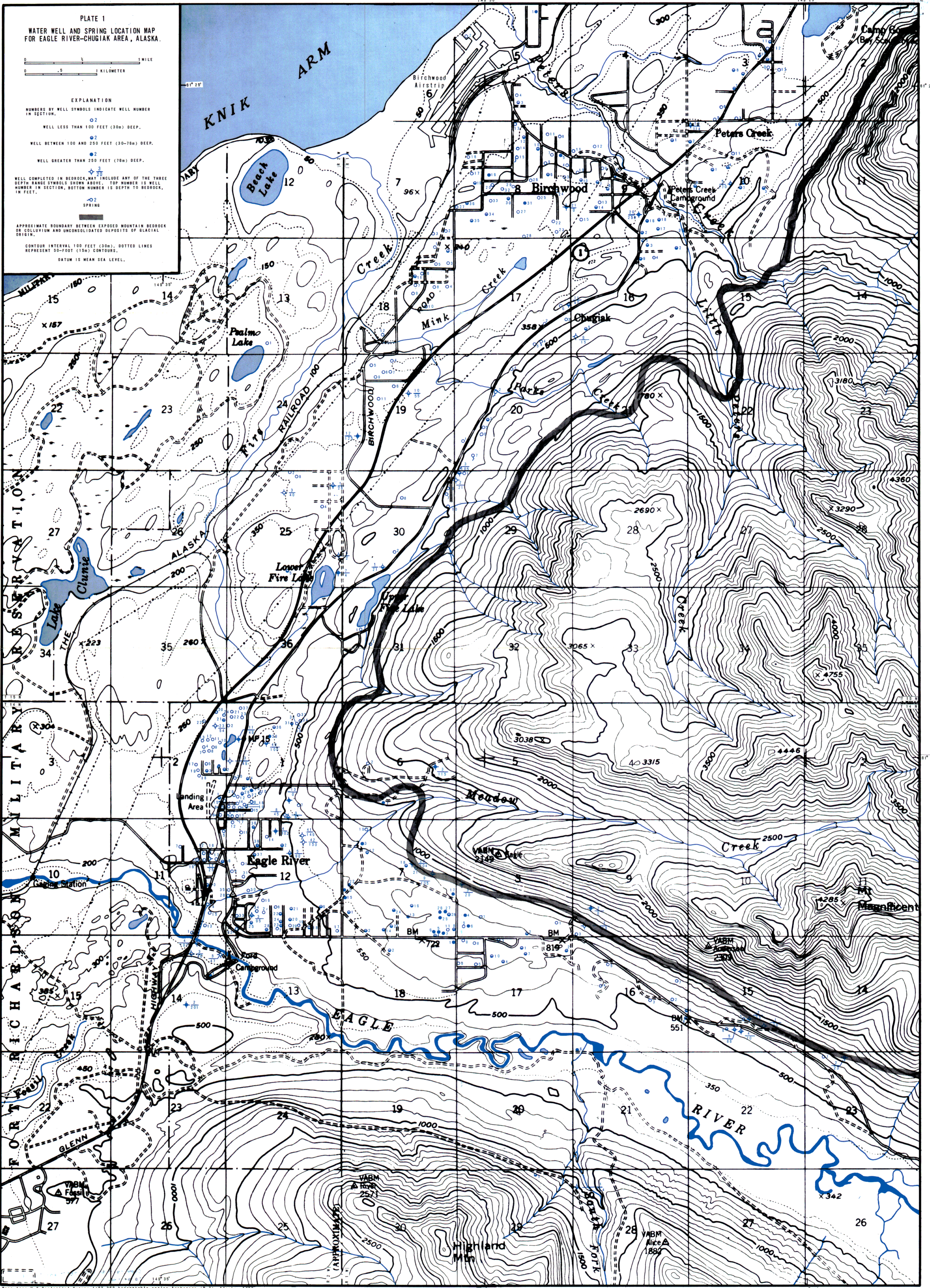


PLATE 1

EXPLANATION

 - ⊙ WELL GREATER THAN 250 FEET (76m) DEEP.
- WELL COMPLETED IN BEDROCK, MAY INCLUDE ANY OF THE THREE DEPTH RANGE SYMBOLS SHOWN ABOVE. TOP NUMBER IS WELL NUMBER IN SECTION, BOTTOM NUMBER IS DEPTH TO BEDROCK, IN FEET.
- SPRING
- APPROXIMATE BOUNDARY BETWEEN EXPOSED MOUNTAIN BEDROCK OR COLLUVIUM AND UNCONSOLIDATED DEPOSITS OF GLACIAL ORIGIN.
