
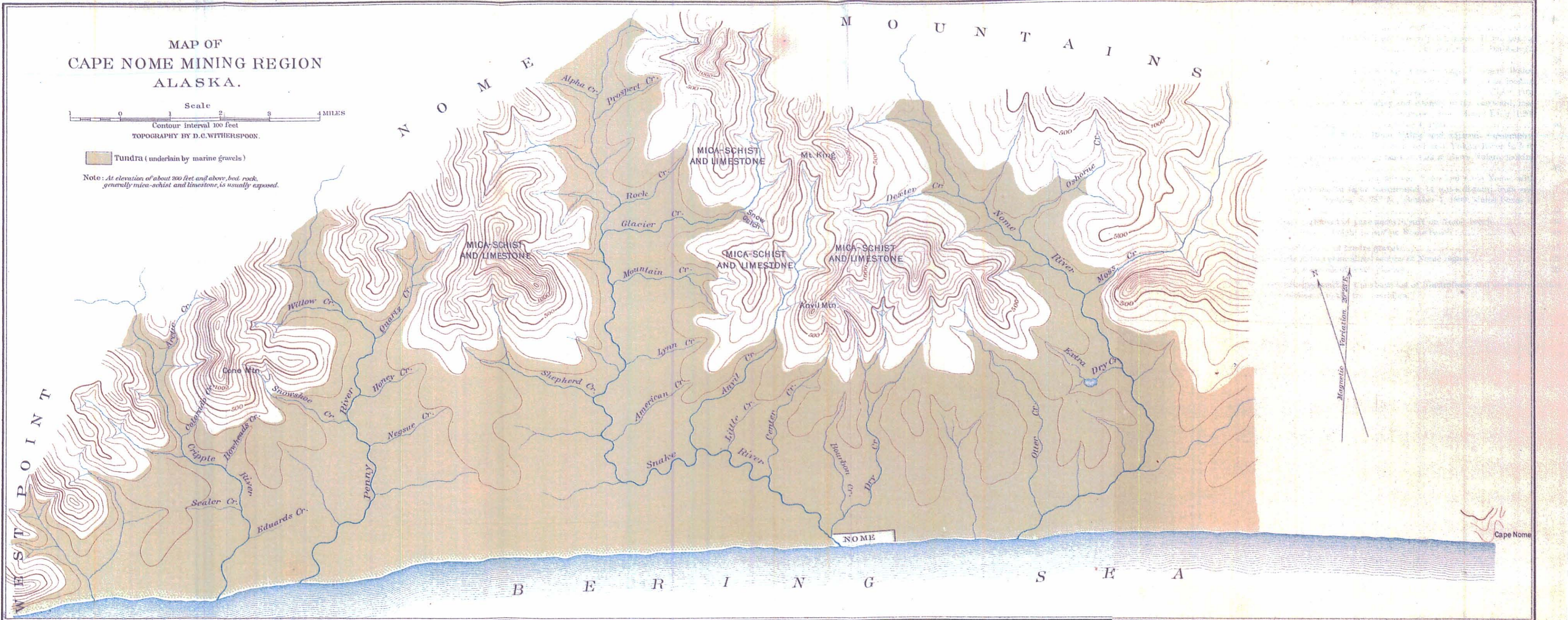


MAP OF CAPE NOME MINING REGION ALASKA.
