MEMORANDUM REPORT

SUBJECT: Mining operations in the Tolovana District, Fairbanks

Precinct, in 1951.

There was a small decrease in the number of men employed in mining in the Tolovana District this season, but the number of active operations remained the same with two of them apparently changing hands.

The Callahan Zinc-Lead Co. started their dredge early in the year and reported a fairly successful digging season in spite of an inefficient and constantly quitting labor force. This company is deeply involved with the RFC, and apparently will continue to be for many seasons.

Carl Parker on Olive Creek was using a variation of the sluiceplate which is the reverse of the usual setup. Here the water is introduced from the side of the plate while the gravel is pushed in from the upper end. Another unusual feature of this operation is that Parker keeps the cut very wet, or "soupy", as he pushes the gravel in. He apparently is of the opinion that the dozer can move more gravel on each "pass" when it is saturated than otherwise, since it moves so much easier. Just before the final bedrock cleanup, he dries up the cut to minimize the gold loss.

Louie Smith did no further prospecting this year, and no work was done on Amy Creek by Cecil Wells.
