The Shallitson Bines, Inc. at one time owned four groups of mining claims. A short study of each of these groups is given in the following report. Accompanying this report is a sketch of the Wining Claims of the Shallitson Mines, Inc. On this sketch are located the various claims of that company.

The First group consisted of the following claims:

1 Above Shallitson 1
1 Below Shallitson 1
Shallitson 1 Association
The Shallitson 2 Association
1 Above Shallitson 2
2 Above Shallitson 2
Shallitson 4

These claims were covered by Mineral Survey No. 1886 and were patented under Patent No. 1115097, issued October 27, 1942. This group is still owned by the Corporation.

The Second group consisted of the following placer claims:

Bertha 32 Incky Stone 10 Rebecca

These claims were covered by Mineral Survey No. 1862. Patent was applied for, but was cancelled October 18, 1932. The last work done on these claims was in July of 1941; however, Intentions To Hold were filed for each succeeding year up to July 1st of 1947. (Proof of Labor, Vol. 226 Page 62). These were filed by the firm of Gray & Gray, Attorneys at Law, 714 Fioneer Building, St. Paul 1, Minnegota. Since July 1st. 1947 no work has been done on the

group. As far as ean be determined, no one has relocated the group; so therefor, the property is open for relocation.

The Third group consisted of the following placer claims:

1) st 52.79

Argus Sentenial (also called Centannial) Hatibra Dream

These claims were never Surveyed. They were last worked in July of 1941, however, the firm of Gray & Gray also filed Intentions To Hold on these up to July 1st, 1947. We work has been done on the ground since then and no other party has located them so they are also open for relocation.

The Fourth and final group consisted of the following lode claims:

Audrey 4+52-80
Shallitson

These claims were located in July of 1932. Since that date, according to all records no assessment work has been done on the claims. Their location with regard to the placer claims is very indefinite. It appears they cover in general the same ground covered by the placer claims. These lode claims have never been relocated and are therefore open for relocation.

It appears that since the properties mentioned above were dropped by the Corporation no individual or company has relocated the ground, nor has any interest been shown in them by any party. All the ground except the Patented group is therefore open for location.

Regarding the company, it was incorporated on April 29th, 1939 through Mr. Leroy M. Sullivan by Mr. Charles Z. Shallit of Nome, Alaska; Mr. Simon L. Lasker of St. Paul, Minnesota; and Mr. Keith Werner of Eau Claire, Wisconsin, for 260,000 shares at one dollar per share. The Clark of the District Court file Mumber is No. 784. Since inception, however, the Copporation has never filed the Ammal Corporation Report with the Clark's Office.

In summary all unpatented property of the Shallitson Mines, Inc. is open for location. He work has been done on the property by any party since 1941, and the ground has open since July 1st, 1947. The Corporation is dilinquent in its Annual Report to the District Court of the Second Division.


