




Scale: 1:85,000

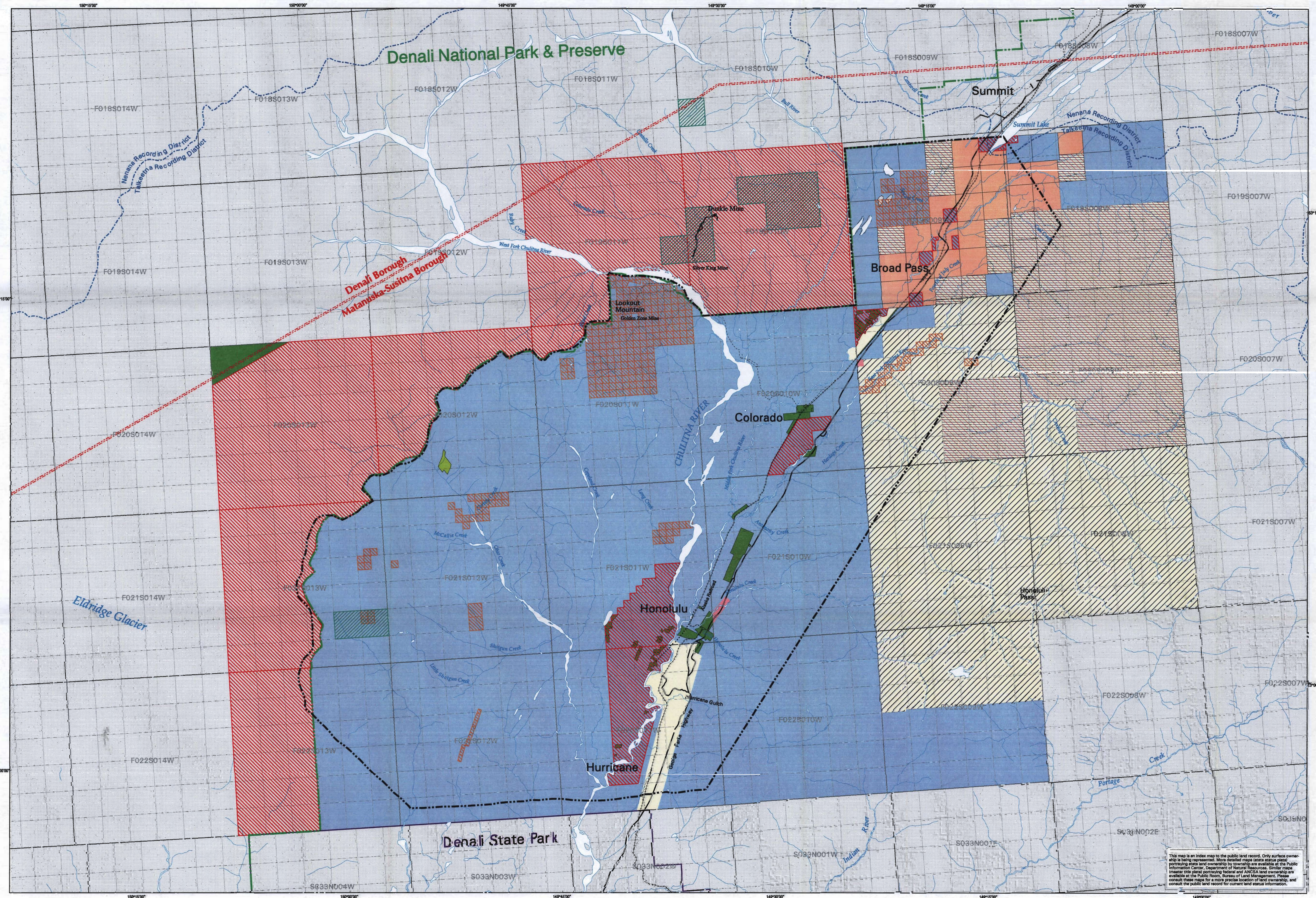
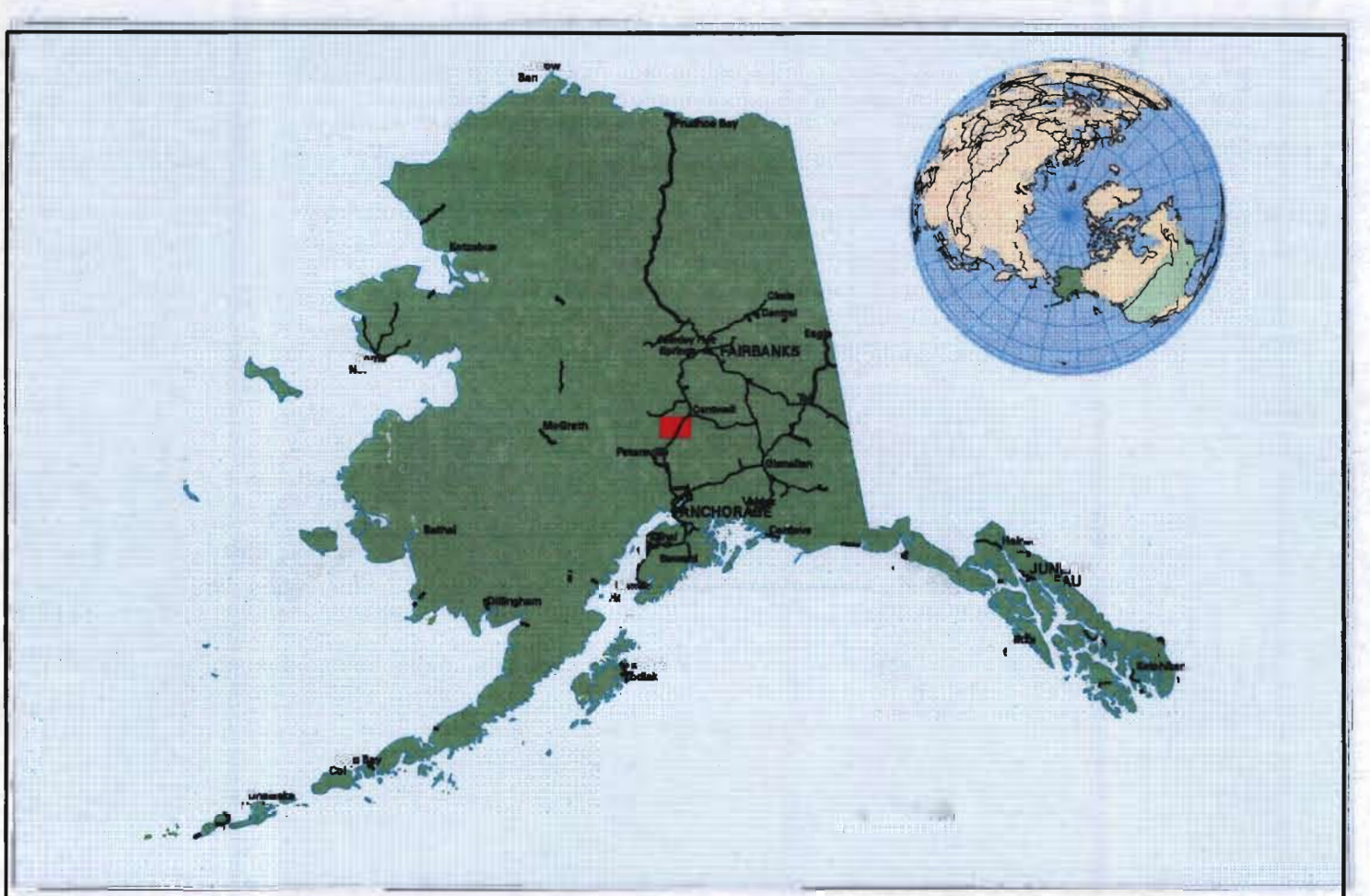
