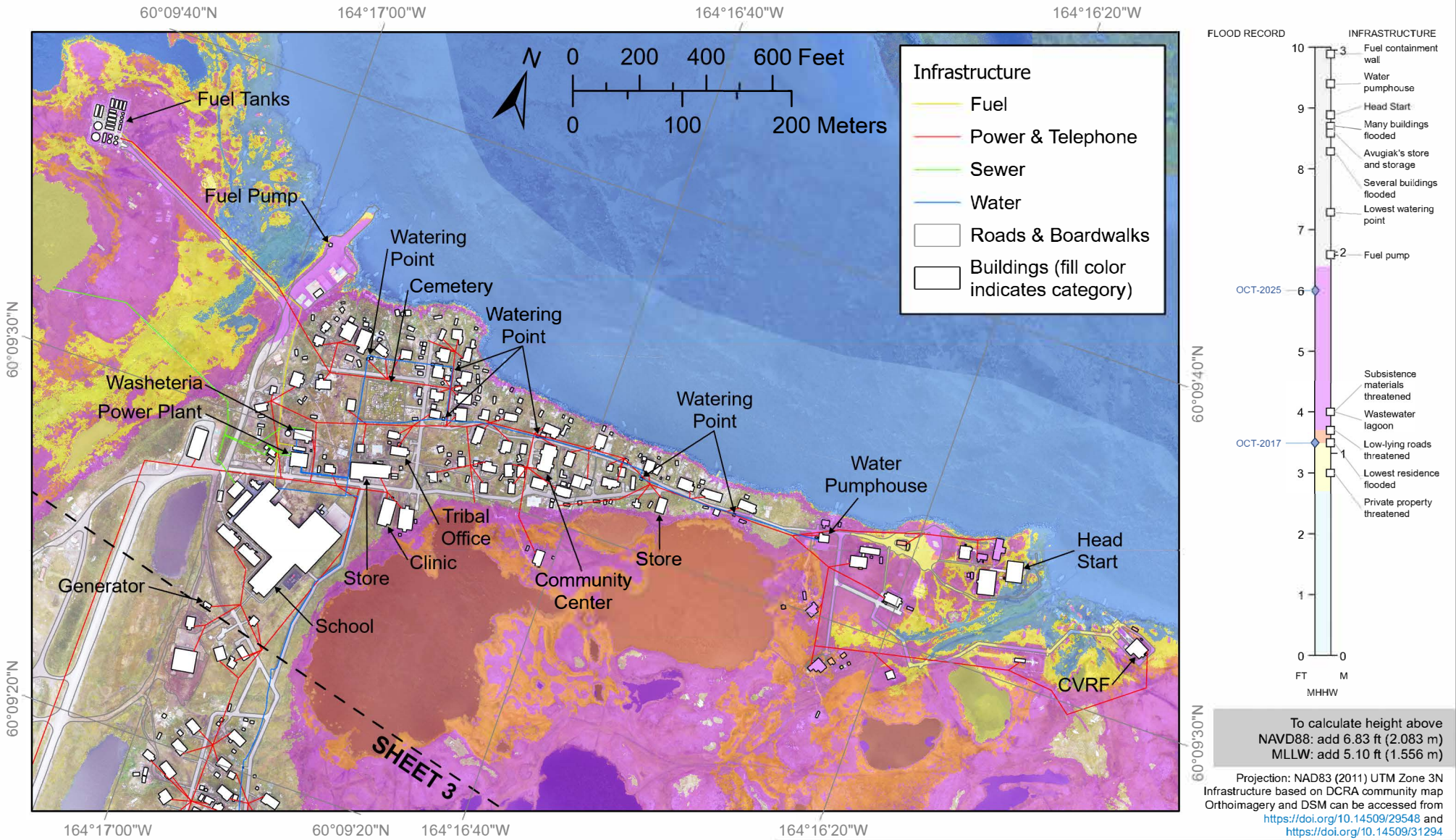


Coastal Flood Impact Map

Minor Flooding is defined as minimal or no property damage. Evacuation of people and/or transfer of property to higher elevations are typically not necessary.
