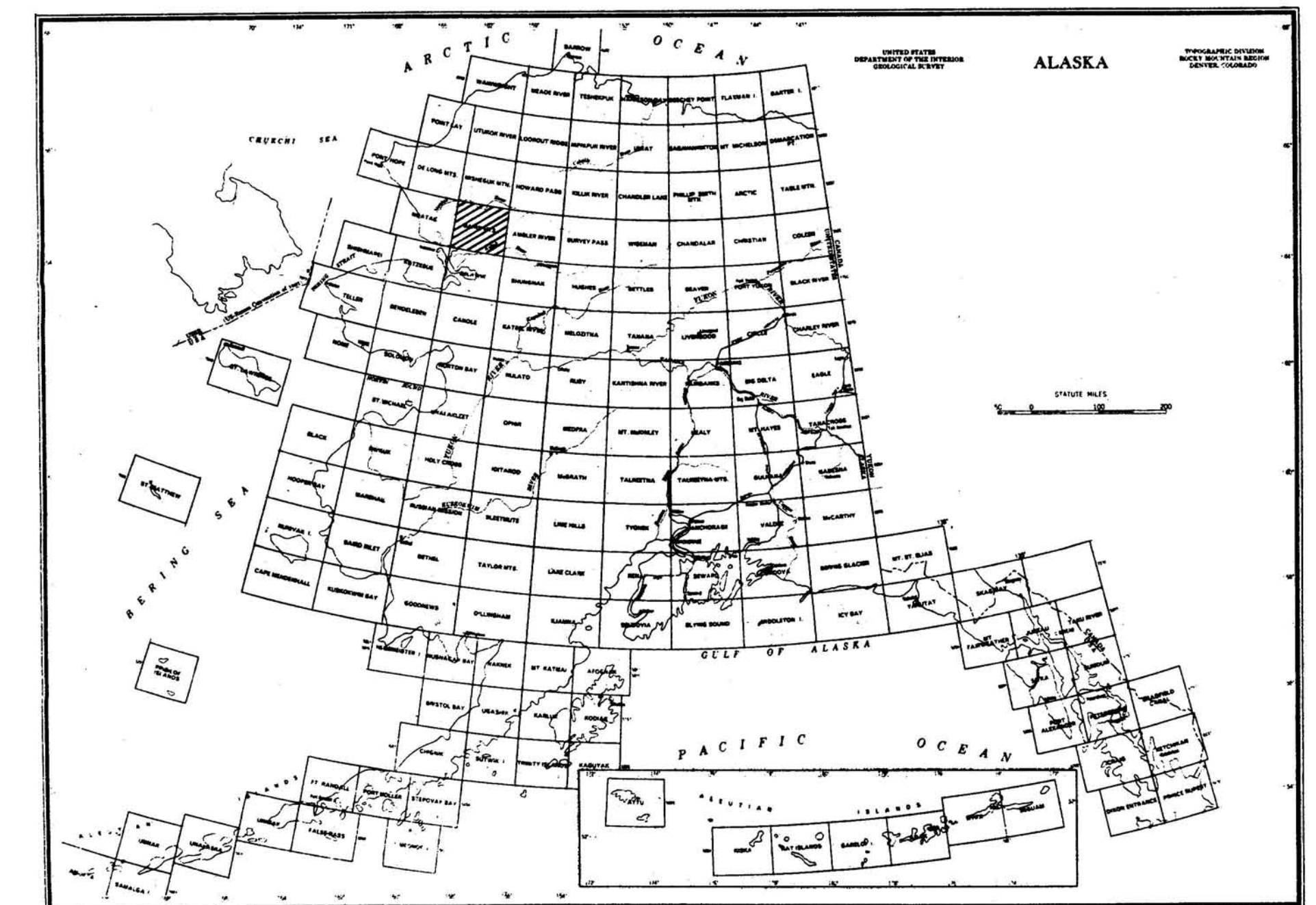

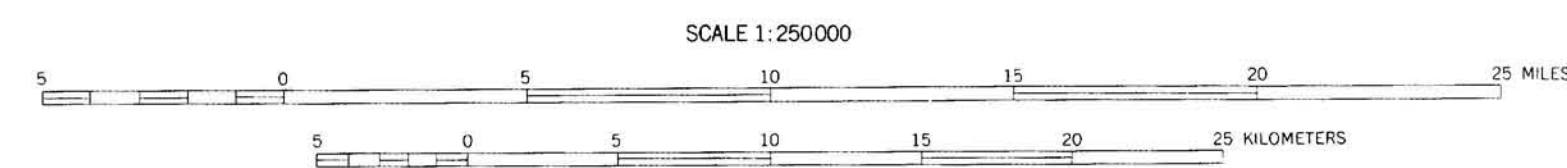


Index map showing location of the Baird Mts. quadrangle.
