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Placer deposit map of central Alaska

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Introduction

This map depicts the location of placer deposits in central Alaska and uses contrasting symbols to show three categories of deposits that are based on the value of estimated production from each placer or, in several cases, from several neighboring placers. With very few exceptions, all data are from published sources. Production data are scarce, usually incomplete, and in many instances were stated for entire mining districts or even larger statistical units. The classification of deposits by amount of production, therefore, is inaccurate and in most cases represents my best guess based on reports of activity, the study of aerial photographs in some areas, and discussion with colleagues familiar with specific mining camps.

Most of the inaccuracies in assigning deposits to categories are between category S (production worth less than \$100,000) and category M (production worth \$100,000 to \$1,000,000). Some of the deposits in category M undoubtedly would be in category L (production worth more than \$1,000,000) if more data were available, but the number of such deposits probably is small. Commodity prices of August 27, 1976, as quoted in The Wall Street Journal, were used to establish production categories. Dollar values translate to rounded off approximate weights of gold as follows:

\$100,000 -- 1,000 fine ounces -- 31,000 grams

\$1,000,000 -- 100,000 fine ounces -- 31,000,000 grams
